

Expired gaming machines tickets payment and unclaimed jackpot prizes

What this form is for

Hotels and registered clubs use this form to pay the value of expired gaming machine tickets or unclaimed jackpot prizes to the Secretary, Department of Customer Service.

Under the Gaming Machines Regulation 2019:

- ▲ A progressive jackpot prize is 'unclaimed' if it hasn't been claimed within 12 months (clause 84(1)).
- ▲ A gaming machine ticket is 'expired' if it hasn't been redeemed within 12 months of issue (clause 109(3)).

Once a jackpot prize becomes unclaimed or gaming machine ticket expires, the amount must be paid to the Secretary within three months.

Note: You may have to pay a penalty of up to \$5,500 if you fail to submit this payment to the Secretary by the due date.
